Addressing the Issue

People with learning disabilities often experience hate crime and hate motivated instances in their every day lives. In many cases people are told to tolerate it or even don't recognise it as anything out of the usual, even fewer cases are reported to the police.

The course will assist support workers in recognising hate incidents and hate crime and how to work with those that they support to be aware of hate crime and how to deal with it.

Police forces across Wales are improving the way they work with people with learning disabilities and how hate crime is handled.

Course includes

- What it feels like to be a victim of hate crime
- Action that can be taken by people with a learning disability and support staff
- What the law says about hate crimes
- Recognising instances of hate crime
- Reporting hate crimes to the police
- What happens once a crime has been reported

This course is co-facilitated by members of Torfaen People First who will share their views, knowledge and experiences.
