

How to Create a Communication Passport

A Communication Passport is a useful tool to help know more about a person's communication. It is a method for individuals who have very limited means to communicate to share important information about themselves and their communication.

A Communication passport can contain any information the person wishes to share. A suggested format can be provided with this guide (see the example pictures below) however pages can be added or omitted, or a new format can be created.

It is suggested a Communication Passport contain information such as:

- Personal information; Name, area in which they live, family, friends info etc.
- Communication; How the person communicates, how much they understand, how to help them etc
- Additional information; Things they like or dislike, things they need help with etc.

The Passport should be written in the first person, should contain photographs or pictures as much as possible, and should be written without large amounts of detail and in simple language.
