We will put a board up for people to write things on if they want help with anything to do with PCP.



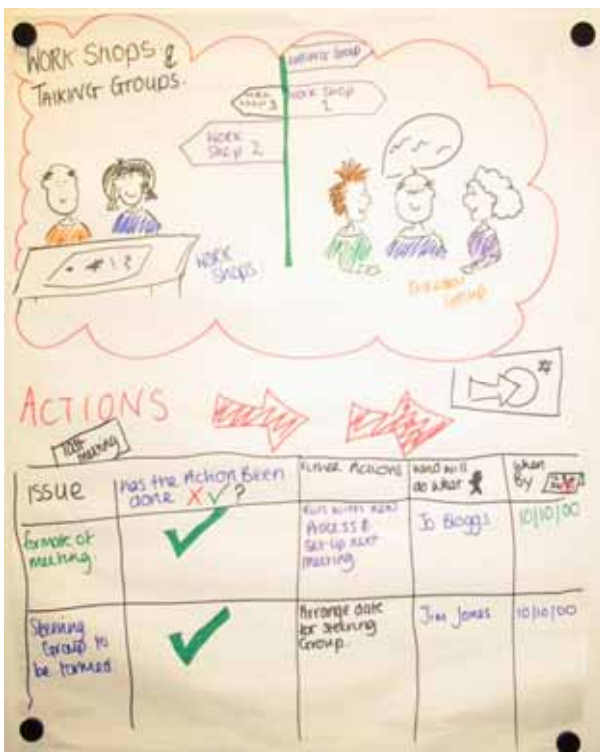
We will have an "Ice-breaker" to get everyone relaxed and talking.
