## What we talked about

### What's happening locally

**Sarah** told us how she has been working with Anuerin Bevan Health Trust to help them to use Person Centred Planning.

She also said that there were some problems locally with Social Services and Health disagreeing over who pays for care.

**Anna** told us about Wrexham CBC moving some of the people they support over to agencies and only keeping services for those that need the most support in house. Anna had some worries about how people they support may be affected so the group gave her some advice.

She has also set up Socialeyes, a group for young people which is very popular.

Anna is also starting to work with a Transitions Social Worker so hopes to get Person Centred Planning used to help young people in transition.

Wrexham have piloted Person Centred Planning reviews, it has been agreed to do a bigger pilot so they are all excited.

**Andrew** told us how despite everyone being worried about cuts in services they are staying positive and looking at ways to make changes to services good ones. He is hoping they will be able to use more personalisation and care management.


**Peter** told everyone how his post is now funded through COASTAL. He has been doing lots of One Page Profiles.

**Vicky** has been doing lots of work around transition and Key working. She has found schools very good at adopting Transition Plans.

She is working on alternatives to statements in Carmarthenshire & Torfaen.

Anna and Sarah both said how they have used Digital Story telling since the July All Wales Person Centred Planning Meeting.
